

Special quadrilaterals: Information sheet

A quadrilateral is a polygon bounded by four line segments.

<p>A trapezium is a quadrilateral with one pair of sides parallel.</p>	
<p>A kite is a quadrilateral with two pairs of adjacent sides equal.</p>	
<p>A parallelogram is a quadrilateral whose opposite sides are parallel.</p>	
<p>A rhombus is a quadrilateral with all sides equal.</p>	
<p>A rectangle is a quadrilateral in which all angles are right angles.</p>	
<p>A square is a quadrilateral that is both a rectangle and a rhombus.</p>
